ARCHETYPE OF THE MONTH

THE EMPRESS

She is called fertile but she is not merely fertile; she is fertility itself, the womb from which all manifest reality continuously pours forth. The Empress embodies the radical truth that the universe is not scarce but endlessly generative, that creation does not deplete but multiplies through the very act of giving. The High Priestess holds the mystery in stillness, the Empress releases it into form.

In Kabbalistic teachings, she is Daleth (T), meaning the door through which all life must pass, the gateway on the path between Chokmah's divine spark and Binah's cosmic womb where raw wisdom first crystallizes into something the hands can hold.



Seated in her garden, she demonstrates that abundance is not something you acquire but something you become. Her throne has no walls because true wealth cannot be hoarded, it flows. She is the reason mystics taught that blessing only remains blessing while it circulates. The moment you dam the river, you create a swamp.

Look at how she holds nothing back. Her wheat grows unharvested at her feet because she knows more will come; has always come, will always come. This is not naive optimism but cosmic law: the force that pushes green through concrete, that fills empty spaces, that converts death into soil into life without hesitation or negotiation.

The pomegranates embroidered upon her dress reminds of Persephone, of Binah, of the fruit split open to reveal countless seeds within seeds; the fractal nature of abundance, each blessing containing infinite future blessings.

The twelve stars crowning her head are not mere decoration but cosmic authority; the zodiac itself bowing to her, all twelve houses of heaven acknowledging that she is the force through which their influences manifest on earth. She wears time as an ornament.

THE EMPRESS

Her scepter, crowned with the orb of earth, declares dominion but not the dominion of conquest but of cultivation. She rules matter because she loves matter, because she understands that spirit divorced from flesh is homeless, that the sacred must be incarnated to be known. Venus, her planet, glows on the heart shaped shield at her feet, stamped with the symbol of love made tangible, desire made productive, beauty made actual.

THE MOVIE OF THE MONTH THE BLUE BUTTERFLY

Pete, a boy dying of cancer wants to see a blue Morpho butterfly before he dies. Alan, the entomologist, resists the journey. He says the Blue Morpho is nearly impossible to catch. It flies erratically, unpredictably. It cannot be trapped through force or strategy.

But was the boy interested in catching it or experiencing it?

Deep in the rainforest, Pete tells Damon that the Morpho's blue is not pigment - it is structure. The wings contain no blue color. They are architecture that makes light become blue. The butterfly does not possess its beauty. It transforms what passes through it.




BOOK OF THE MONTH

SUPERNATURE by Lyall Watson

Watson was a biologist who dared to suggest that nature does not end at the boundary of your skin, proposing a "biology of the unconscious" where life is not a series of isolated islands but a single, breathing grid.

Watson presents scientific evidence that life is a shared field. When a plant is threatened, other plants react. When the tide turns, the oyster opens.



Watson speaks of a "life tide", a cosmic rhythm that connects the enzymes in your blood to the movement of the moon and the silent screams of a plant. He argues that what we call the supernatural is merely nature that is too vast for our limited logic to classify.

One of the most important things when you're looking at The Empress is to understand that you are not living in a closed system. One of the things the scarcity mindset that you cling to is based on this false premise that you are a closed system.




